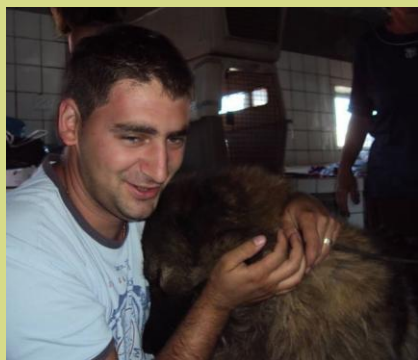

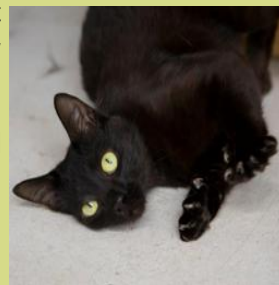

Rufus' Happy Ever After Story

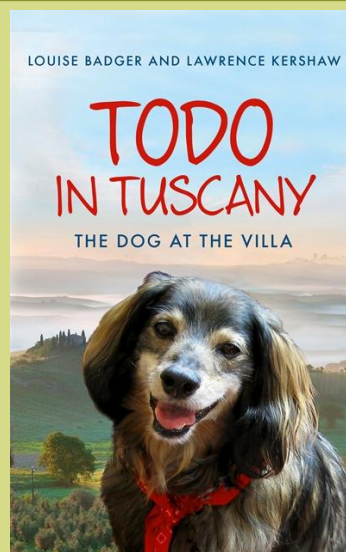
