WINTER 2014 TO BE LONGEST IN HISTORY

Heavy snow could fall until MAY warn forecasters!!!!!!

If forecasters are to be believed there will be thousands of dog walkers wondering how best to care for their dogs paws when walking in freezing, snowy conditions. Snow and ice gets trapped between their pads and this will obviously hurt and can cause cuts and abrasions, it also means that they may slip as their paws will not be able to grip as they walk.



We suggest that you trim your dog's nails and the fur between their toes to a level that is parallel with their pads; this should reduce the amount of snow and ice that gets trapped. When you get home from a snowy icy walk it is best to let the ice melt on your dog's paws rather than try to remove it, you could inadvertently hurt them and they may be reluctant to let you look at their paws in the future.

If the winter is as bad as predicted you may want to consider buying boots for your dog, there are many companies who sell an amazing array of boots and shoes that will keep your dogs feet warm and dry and will be safer for them when walking in icy conditions.

A word of warning: if you are anything like me, barely able to stay upright in wintery conditions, please take care out there!



Transport Day 3 December

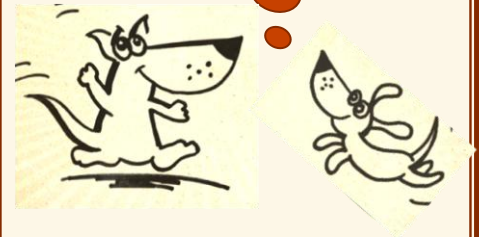
