URGENT APPEAL

We need to raise £1,800 to pay for surgery for Renata.

This remarkable 5 year old girl was rescued from the illegal kill shelter in Zarnesti. It was apparent she had been badly abused, worse of all was the problem with one of her back knees. Once in the UK the decision was taken to operate to relieve the problem, our only alternative would be to amputate!



Renata has suffered so much, she has many scars and her ears show signs of maltreatment.

Currently she is suffering from the skin condition Demodex, her skin is sore, it itches and she is having to endure daily baths. Despite all of this she is such a stoical girl and her loving personality just shines through.

Once Renata's skin issues have been resolved we will immediately organise her surgery. She is young, healthy dog and this surgery is crucial to ensure her comfort and well being.

The Roby & Rick Story

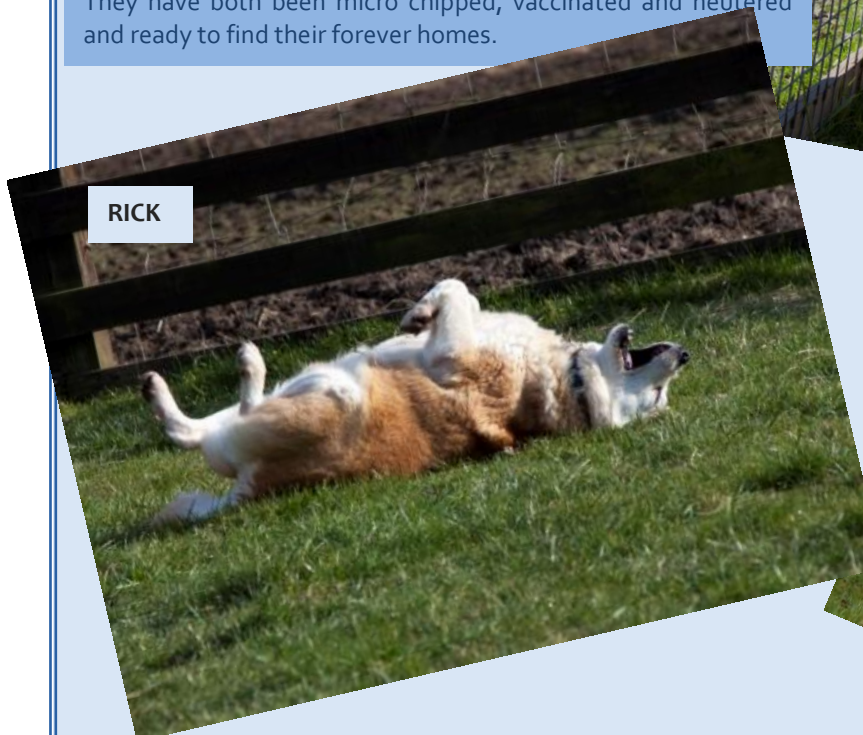
