At the kennels we are looking forward to longer, sunnier and warmer days... with less mud, so all the kids can make the most of our new freedom field!

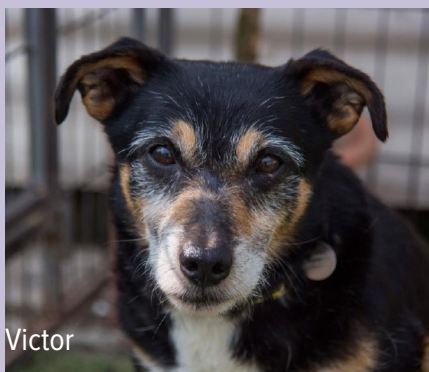
It has been a busy few months at Love Underdogs, we have already welcomed one transport of newbies in February and another transport last week.

All our newbies are being assessed and are starting to become available for adoption, so keep an eye on our website!

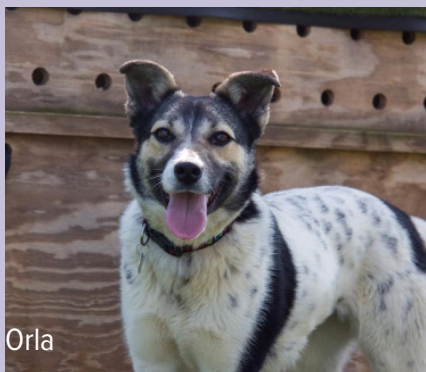

Our colleague Petra works daily with our dogs and records in the greatest minutia the outcome reactions and how the dogs process their emotions, what oils were selected by the dog and their effects.

Anyone who might have initially thought this work was a little out there and who works with the dogs daily at the kennels have really come to see the most incredible results following sessions.

The dogs process trauma, learn to be calm, and move towards a more balanced state which ultimately helps their wellbeing. It also makes them more adoptable. We have seen dogs transformed post session. Petra's work is now a very important part of our rehabilitation programme.



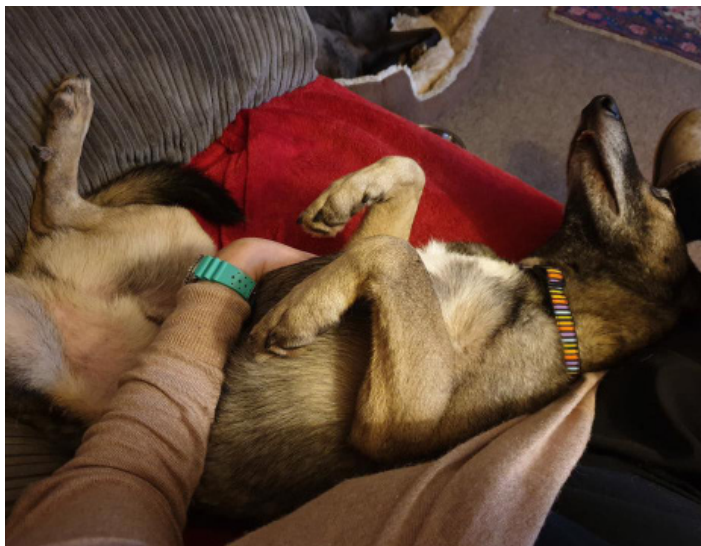
Journey to a home

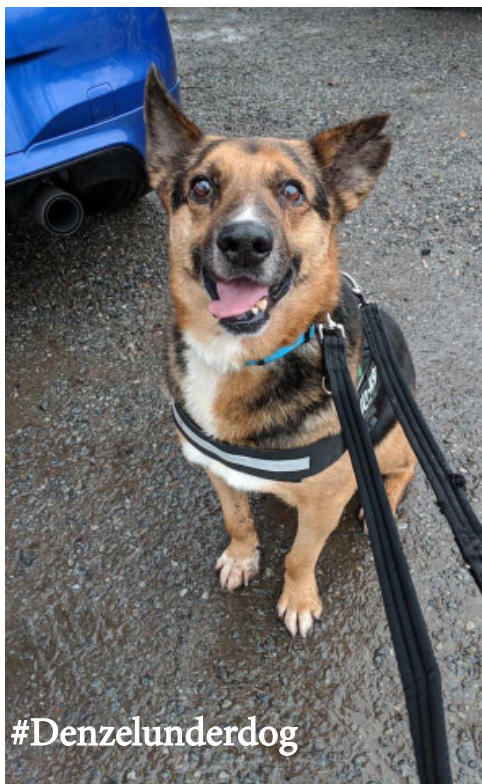
